Shape	<p>Build a tower using recyclable items.</p>	<p>Collect and sort items around the house. Put items into groups and label.</p>
Measure	<p>Go around the house and find items that are bigger/smaller than a metre (record results).</p>	<p>Measure the people in your household feet.</p> <p>Order from the smallest to the largest.</p> <p>You can use a standard or non-standard unit of measure.</p>
Statistics	<p>Create a home visual timetable</p>	<p>Create a pictogram based on your favourite treats in your home.</p>
Fractions	<p>Cut a pizza into even slices for you and your family.</p> <p>How many slices did you cut the pizza into? How many slices did you get?</p> <p>What would the fraction be?</p>	<p>Draw a circle and decorate it.</p> <p>Fold it in half.</p> <p>Fold it again.</p> <p>Cut the circle into even parts.</p>
