Coronavirus (COVID-19): School reopening arrangements to NURSERY

Dear Parents and Carers of our Nursery classes,

I would like to begin by offering a huge 'thank you' for supporting the school over recent weeks and for supporting your child with their home learning.

As you will be aware, the government has asked schools to plan for reopening from 1st June 2020 for: Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. Schools will also continue to operate a childcare facility for: Children of critical workers, Vulnerable pupils: those with a EHCP, with a Social Worker, or those with vulnerability to whom the school have decided to offer a childcare place.

At Laycock, we have taken the advice and guidance from the Government and our Local Authority, undertaken risk assessments and considered our staff capacity to make the decision, subject to the government confirming that it is safe to do so, that from **Monday 8th June** we will be opening our Nursery to **offer a very limited number of spaces**. At the moment we will only be able to consider children of critical workers, vulnerable pupils: those with a EHCP, with a Social Worker, or those with vulnerability to whom the school have decided to offer a childcare place. The Nursery day will run from 9.30am-3.00pm and will be in smaller 'bubbles' of 8 children. Once we know the numbers and final class list, we will communicate further detailed plans including staggering start and end times, our risk assessment and other arrangements.

If you feel your child falls into one of these categories and you would like them to be considered for one of these full time places (regardless of either they were full or part time pre lockdown), please can you fill in the form overleaf and email to Mr Biles on s.biles@laycock.islington.sch.uk by Monday 1st June 2020.

We are very much looking forward to seeing many of our children across the school once again, but I would like to reassure you that the safety of our school community is our priority. We appreciate how difficult it is for very young children to be able to understand the concept of social distancing and to be able to do this practically. All of these concerns will be addressed in our rigorous risk assessment and reviewed weekly. If you would like to talk to us about your child and any concerns you have about their return to school, please – in the first instance – email Mr Biles who will reply after the half term break.

If your child has an EHC plan please contact the school Sue Brownson or Amzee Perera, who will support you and your child with their return to school.

Keeping your child at home

Remote learning will continue for those children re are remaining at home from Wednesday 3rd June as our teacher have staff training on Monday 1st June and Tuesday 2nd June.
