Coronavirus (COVID-19): Remote learning

Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to begin by offering a huge 'thank you' for supporting the school over recent weeks and for supporting your child with their home learning.

As you will be aware, the Government has asked schools to plan for reopening from 1st June 2020 for: Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. Schools will also continue to operate a childcare facility for: Children of critical workers, Vulnerable pupils: those with a EHCP, with a Social Worker, or those with vulnerability to whom the school have decided to offer a childcare place.

At Laycock, we have taken the advice and guidance from the Government and our Local Authority and made the decision, subject to the government confirming that it is safe to do so, to reopen for Reception, Year one and Year six. Nursery are having a different set up which has been communicated separately. If your child is currently attending our setting because you fall into one of the above categories, you will be contacted separately also.

This means that Year two, three, four and five will **continue to stay at home and access their remote learning**. We have a dedicated team of teachers who will be running the home learning on Class Dojo and will provide printed packs for families who have shown interest in them.

If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 6 and you are choosing not to send your child into school, home learning will continue for you also. You will be getting the same work and projects as those in school, with a particular focus on consolidating skills in English & Maths. We will not be introducing any new learning to ensure the work we set for children at home is achievable and appropriate to their year group.

We understand the pressure home learning can have on you as parents and hope that we are helping as best as we can through the learning platform Class Dojo. Miss Evans, our Assistant Head Teacher, is leading our remote learning team and can answer any questions or queries you may have. She can be contacted on Class Dojo or by ringing the school office.

During this difficult time, we have mixed our staff team up and prioritised certain people to work from home. Therefore, your child will be receiving work from have a different 'remote learning teacher' to their usual school teacher, however, they can and will still be accessing Class Dojo and can be contacted if you need to.

As of Wednesday the 3rd of June, your remote learning teacher will be in contact with you and happy to help with any learning needs. Our teachers are having staff training on Monday 1st and Tuesday 2nd June. If you are working from home, you can expect the following:

- Regular updates, messages and videos from me (Miss Laz)
- Daily lessons uploaded: phonics(KS1)/ spelling (KS2), Maths, English
- Project based learning
- PSHE lessons based on our current situation
- Teachers will continue to comment and approve work
- Dojo points will continue to be awarded for home learning

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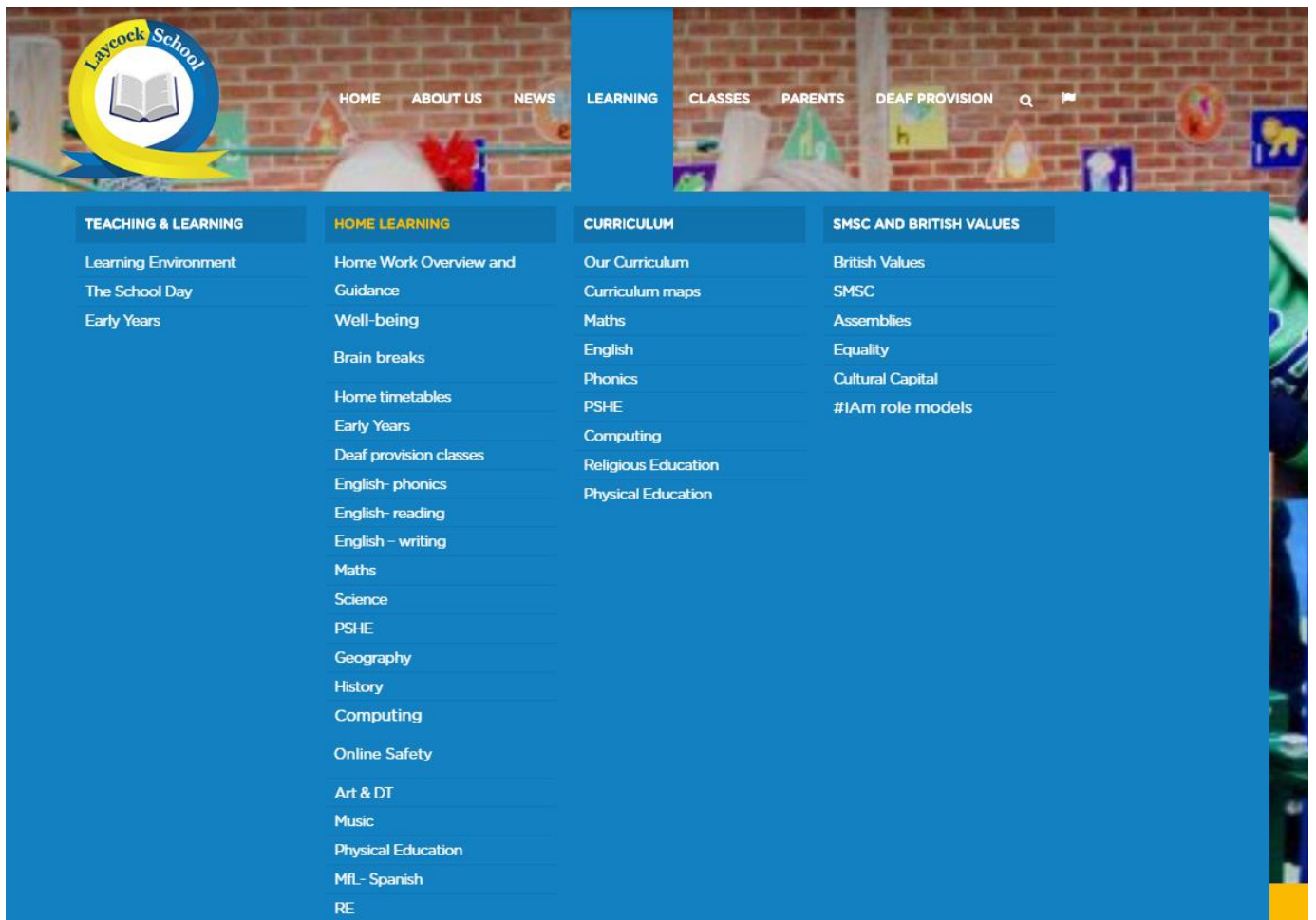
